

Attendance Policy

Academic credit for a course requires regular class attendance, whether or not this is stated in the syllabus, and is not just a matter of completing the assignments. Attendance means being present in the class for the entire scheduled class meeting, not just some part of it. In the event of absence for any reason, the student is responsible for any information or class content missed. The professor may require additional work to make up for an absence. A student who is absent from a significant portion of the course and frequently late for class meetings equivalent to more than nine (9) class hours even due to extenuating circumstances will receive a failing grade for the course.
